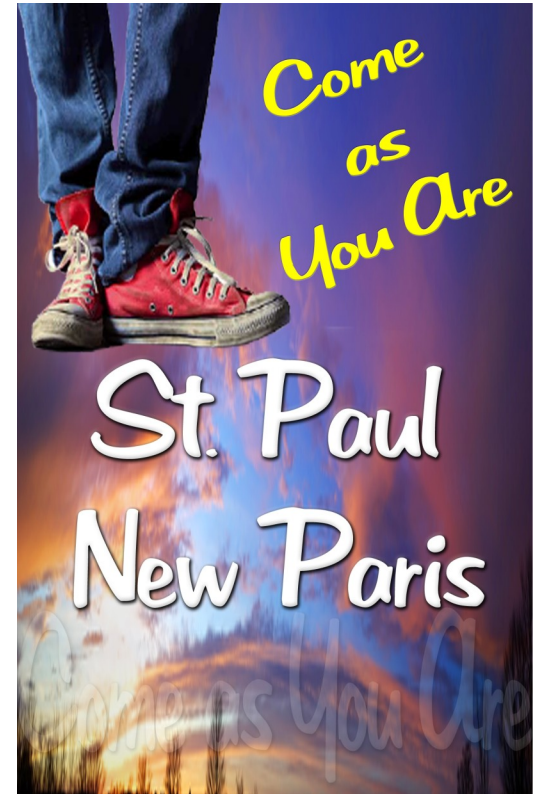

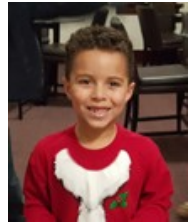
Outreach to Many
