MONTHLY SHIPMENT FROM SHARED HARVEST FOOD BANK

- Our mission is to provide 3-4 days' worth of food and toiletries to those in need within our community. We follow federal income guidelines in determining client eligibility. We conduct interviews to build relationships with those we are serving and gain knowledge of other areas where there is a need.
- We serve the areas of Jackson and Jefferson Townships in Preble County, Ohio.
- We offer resource and community information as well as information for special events like the Day of Caring, community dinners or school supplies and shoes giveaway.

Policies and Procedures

You may visit once every 28-30 days. Please bring a picture ID and proof of residency for each visit. You must reside in Jefferson or Jackson Township in Preble County Ohio. You will be asked to provide a signature at each visit. Every client must attend an interview to be served more than once.
